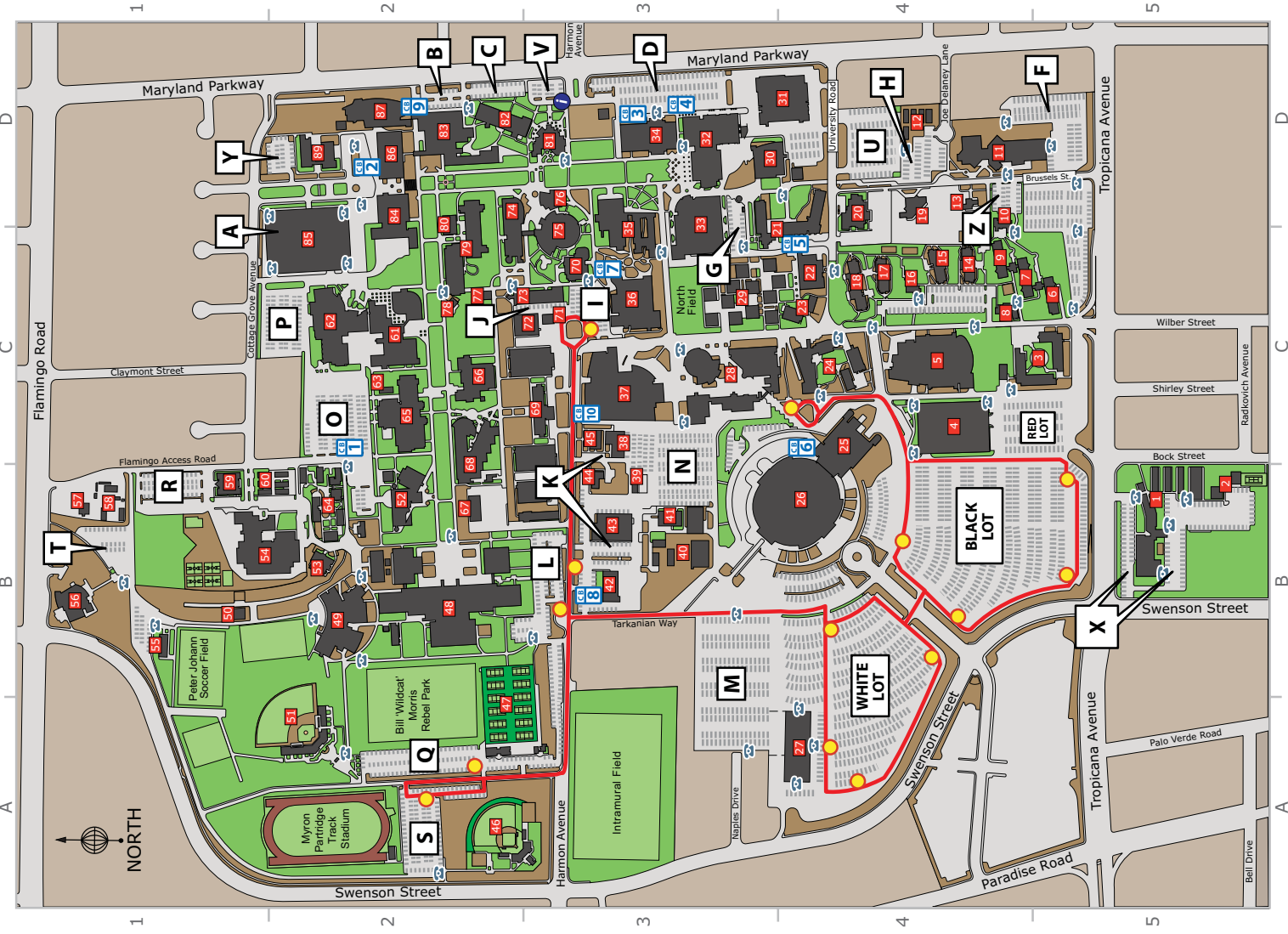


EVENT LOCATION MAP

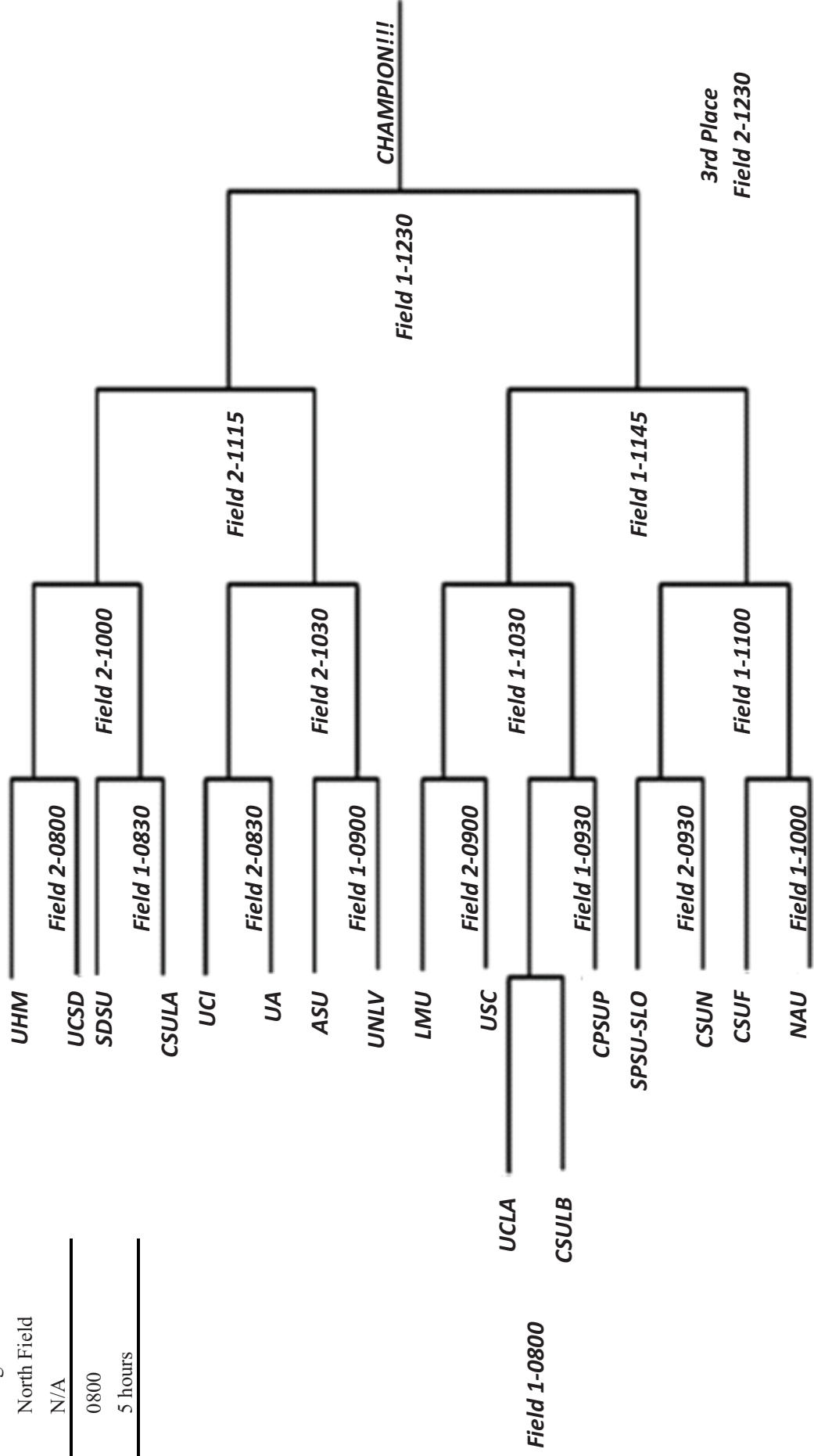

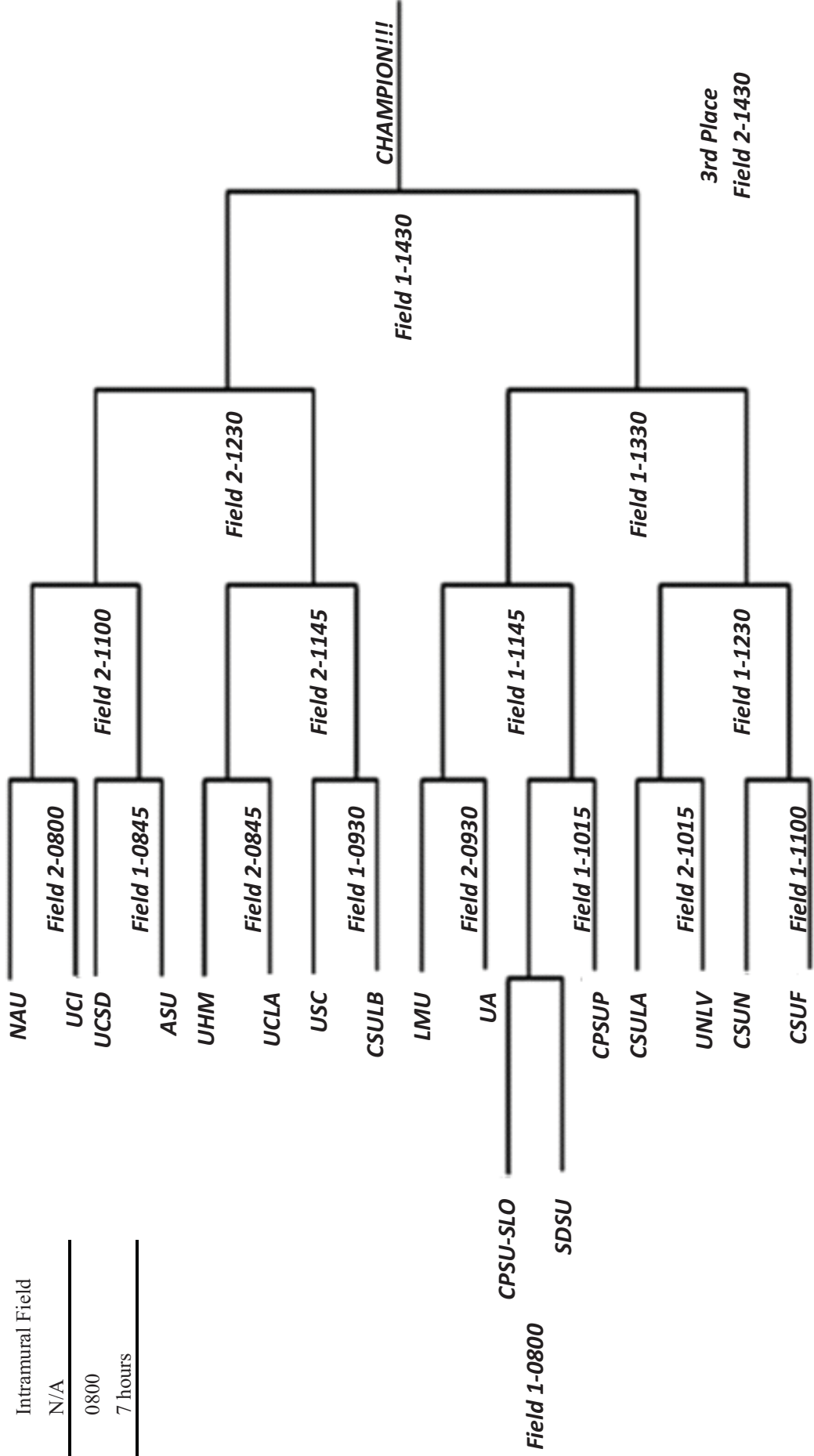
