

Survey Competition Scoring

Since the Surveying Event is a competition of accuracy, the scoring is going to be a little bit different than the other events. The Survey event will be scored on the angle turning event and the level loop event with the chaining event and the Equipment set up event as tie breakers. The Chaining event will serve as the first tier tie breaker. The Equipment set up will be used as the second tier tie breaker. Places for each event will be provided as “bragging rights” for the schools. There will be an overall 1st, 2nd, and 3rd awards for the event. Scoring for the level loop and the angle turning will be scored individually by the most accurate receiving 17 points and the least accurate receiving 1 point. We will allow a tie in the individual events. The combination of the level loop and the angle turning loop scores will be combined to form the total score for each school. In the event that there is a tie, the chaining event will be addressed between the two schools, the school with the best accuracy between the two schools will be awarded an extra point to give them the place. In the event that the two schools are in a tie in the chaining event, the two schools will then be examined in the Equipment Set up event. The school with the fastest time will be awarded the place.
